



The St. Ann Knights college scholarship program began in 1992 and continues through to this day. Each year, the Knights of Council 10245 award scholarships to two very deserving college-bound high school students from the St. Ann Parish.

The first two years were funded by a raffle of an autographed football by the Dallas Cowboys. Brother Knight and then Dallas Cowboy defensive coordinator, Dave Wanstead had the ball autographed by the entire team and offered it to the raffle. That team went on to win the Super Bowl, both years.
